Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

On March 5th, we begin the season of Lent and our journey to the cross and the empty tomb. Often, Lent is a time of self-reflection on where we are in error with our relationship with God, and how we can get better.

With our ministry theme this year FulFilled, our focus during this Lenten season is on being Filled with Abundance. Since it is Lent, we certainly could say, "Being filled with an abundance of sin." But instead, we're going to focus on the abundance of God. Specifically, God is filled with an abundance of Faithfulness, Mercy, Compassion, Forgiveness, and Love.

The Gospel readings throughout Lent this year show us God's abundance. We hear about God's Faithfulness during Jesus' temptations in the wilderness. We read about God's Mercy when Jesus talks about gathering God's children together. We sense God's Compassion when Jesus heals a woman who was bent over for 18 years. We feel God's Forgiveness when Jesus tells the parable of the Prodigal Son. We experience God's Love when Mary anoints Jesus with oil at Lazarus' house.

As we begin this season of Lent, may you be filled with God's abundance.

Raise the Roof

On October 13th, we voted to replace our hail damaged roof with a metal shake roofing material. Our congregation decided that of all the options available, this is the best structural and financial option for Our Savior's. Doing this upgrade will require an additional \$50,000 after the insurance proceeds. In the coming weeks, you will be invited to participate in our *Raise the Roof* campaign.

Worship & Music Team

The Worship and Music Team meets the 4th Monday of the month. The last meeting was January 27, 2025; there was not a meeting in February. Members of this team include Pastor Anthony, Kevin Beuning, Lisa Beuning, Renee Stark, Ruth Fauk, Kay Schmainda, and Mike Aronson who organizes and facilitates their meeting.

Items on the agenda included planning for upcoming worship experiences in February and March with notable dates for Adult Choir and the Praise team. They celebrated the addition of a drummer to the praise team. The team does a great job anticipating and coordinating the "extras" that may be needed for special services - such as Audio Visual (AV) knowing to prep additional microphones for the passion reading on Palm Sunday (thanks Kevin!)

Some time was spent discussing optimum timing and services for the Lenten season as well as Holy Week. Using attendance data from last year, the team decided to hold one evening service for Ash Wednesday at 6:00 with dinner served at 5:00. Additionally, the team discussed leadership needs for organizing the Easter Vigil on Saturday, April 19. Pastor Anthony will consider modifications that could be made and will think about other options.

Finally, the team also debriefed the change in our timing for Christmas services. The 3:00 pm service was received favorably, it worked well for many families. Our attendance was 131 at 3:00 pm and 121 at 5:30 pm; this was an overall increase over last year when services were held at 5:30 and 10:00 pm. The team recommended we use this same schedule for Christmas 2025.

The Worship and Music Team will meet again on March 24, 2025.
